PHASE ONE

NOW

1. Masks strongly encouraged inside (and worn by trustees and pastor)
2. Social distancing with tape
3. offering in back
4. no shaking of hands (pastor/members) discourage congregating inside.
5. Fellowship hall still set up for worship.

Outdoor worship signs to designate parking spots, trustee outside, and fm transmitter

COMMUNION

--self-contained communion cups for all

PHASE TWO 4 weeks from NOW of Brown Co. COVID cases going down (earliest August 5th)

1. Masks strongly encouraged inside (and worn by trustees and pastor)

2. Remove social distancing tape.

3. offering in back
4. no shaking of hands (pastor/members) discourage congregating inside.
5. Fellowship hall still set up for worship.

Outdoor worship continues. signs to designate parking spots, trustee outside, and fm transmitter

COMMUNION

individual bread on a plate spread out and cups spaced out AND self-contained communion cups offered for those inside and outside. Communion brought to you by masked pastor and masked elder).

PHASE THREE 4 weeks from Phase Two of Brown Co. COVID cases going down (earliest (Sept. 6th)

1. Masks optional for those inside
3. offering in back
4. Pastor greets but doesn't shake hands. congregating inside ok
5. Fellowship hall returns to normal. In-person Bible Class /Confirmation resumes.
6. Hymnals return. Hymns still printed for outdoor worshippers

Outdoor worship continues. signs to designate parking spots, and fm transmitter. trustee (inside and outside)

COMMUNION

Communion front of church (not at the rail)
Inside: individual bread on a plate spread out and cups spaced out in tray.

Outside: Self-contained communion cups

Pastor and elder publically sanitize hands before distribution. No masks.

New Normal
3. offering in back
4. Pastor greets people on the way out (shaking hands optional).

Outdoor worship continues. signs to designate parking spots, and fm transmitter. trustee (inside and outside)

COMMUNION

Inside: Communion front of church (not at the rail)

Outside: Self-contained communion cups

Pastor and elder publically sanitize hands before distribution. No masks.
